
- 1. Hold french fry bags or boxes in one hand.
- Insert the bottom part of the scoop into the bag or box. See figure 1.
- While holding the bag or box against the back of the scoop, insert the scoop into a pile of fries.
- Raise the scoop to the vertical position. This will cause the fries to slide into the bag or box. See figure 2.

IMPORTANT: With a little practice the operator can estimate a bag or boxful of fries by sight before they are inserted.

5. Transfer the bag or box of fries to the holding rack.
